


- 3. PLEASE, do not use dark colored paper for your tags. They are extremely hard to read.
- 4. And again, please write legibly on your tags, and if you put a lot of information on the tags, please consider using larger tags.
- 5. Remember that the displays are managed displays. Ask Linda or other staff members before putting your items in the displays.
- 6. It would be greatly appreciated if when you remove your file from the boxes to check sales that you put the files back in numerical order.
- 7. Please use extreme caution when bringing items down the ramp! There is getting to be a lot of wear and tear on the bannister posts, and broken twinkle lights!
- 8. When you are restocking your booths, please be considerate of customers as they shop and sales staff as furniture is moved out!
