Sales for the 14 days we were open in May were \$21,823.75. That is up \$1406.58 over May of 2019 which was a full month!! Our customers were ready to shop, and they are still shopping! We are having great sales. Thank you for keeping your booths well stocked!

It has been so good to see all of you in the store, visiting, bringing in new items and refreshing your booths. We have had so many comments from the customers about how good the store looks. Customers notice the cleaning you and the staff have been doing. It shows and I thank you for it!

We are not requiring customers to wear masks or face covering, but we are encouraging it. We do "very strongly encourage" all vendors to wear masks or face covering when they are in the store stocking or working their spaces for longer than one hour, and/or interacting with customers. I do appreciate all of you that are adhering to the guidelines. The staff are required to wear a mask while helping anyone in the store and that includes when you as vendors come behind the counter. We have the sneeze guard in front of the cash register as a good protection for the staff when customers are checking out.

Now just a few housekeeping items:

- When you are working in your booths, I am asking that you be finished and out of the store by closing time. I need the staff to have all of their attention focused on the closing procedures. Thank you.
- Please remember that the back rooms are not for storing your items, display or seasonal sales items. I will be marking some "left behind" items in the work room and layaway area and you will have 30 days to claim them and remove them from the store or put them in your booths. After that, those items will be sold or disposed of.
- We seem to be having a lot of items coming to the sales area with no tags or with tags missing information. Please remember that correctly filled out tags equal money in your pocket. Items without tags translate to no sale.

In closing a thought attributed to Maya Angelou: "Every storm runs out of rain." When I think of this statement, I think of how it feels after a nice rain; clean, fresh, rejuvenated, and better. Please remember that this storm we are going through will end and we will come out better on the other end. Keep up the good work and "be of good cheer!"
